My name is Zach, I'm 29, I was born and raised in Turlock and grew up in a Christian home. Somewhere along the way some things happened and I became agnostic. I've been on and off meth and heroin my whole adult life. A few years ago I had started doing well for myself. I had my own place, a good job, I got engaged, and my son was born.

Eventually the drugs started taking control so I got even deeper into my addiction. It got to the point where I lost my fiancé, my car, and my house. Now I was homeless and decided to quit my job and steal from stores, houses, and people instead of collecting a paycheck. After my son got taken away I ended up in the hospital where the doctors said I was dying from an infection of my lungs and it spread to the heart. After a long recovery when I finally got discharged, I ended up relapsing again.

My family didn't know what to do with me anymore. That's when I knew that I needed help and came to Adult and Teen Challenge. Since I've been here I began to follow God and I got baptized. One evening when I went to a church revival an Evangelist named Billy Burke was preaching. God instantly healed me physically through the laying on of hands. But most importantly I'm getting my relationship back with my family again. I can't wait to see what else God has planned for my life.

My name is Paul Carey Jr. I found myself enveloped by an addiction that started around the age of 16. Throughout the years I tried many ways to break myself of this ever-binding addiction but nothing worked. To the outside world I had been given everything a child could want, but inside my heart I always felt broken and left behind which I know fueled the beginning of my addiction. My addiction kept growing to the point where I found meth and then it was truly all over from there.

Within 6 months of using meth I became a felon on felony probation and found myself in jail for months. It got so bad I even tried to take my own life.

Fast forward a few years, and through God's grace, I got placed into Faith Home Teen Challenge instead of a lengthy prison term.

One year later I am now a graduate and a student leader at the ranch and have now been more than one year sober. My relationship with my once broken family is now better than I could ever have imagined. And I give all the glory to my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

I truly met my Lord Jesus Christ at the ranch. I owe this place my life. I would not change the path that God had me travel to get here and the scars I obtained on the way. For the scars I have now I can use to minister in such a direct way and Faith Home Teen Challenge is training me in new ways each and every day.
