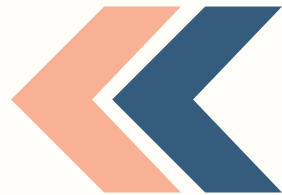

I became addicted to alcohol and drugs at an early age. Since then I've had many short periods of sobriety, all of which were attempts to stay clean on my own willpower.

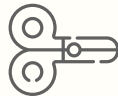
