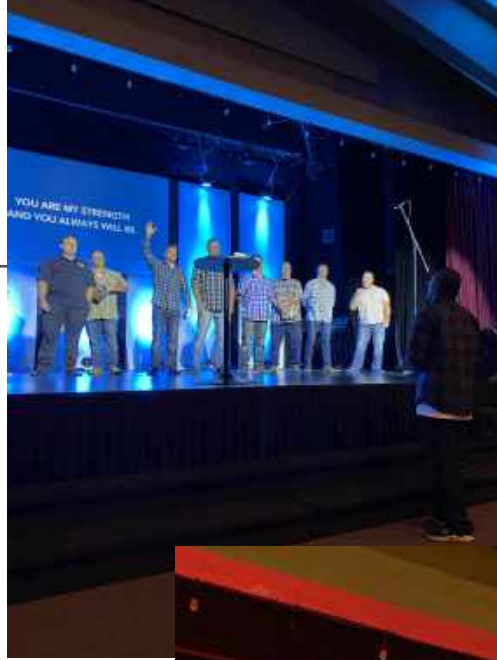
ALL ABOUT OUR OUTINGS
