ZACK JACKSON - ON CERTIFICATION AS A

Substance Abuse Counselor



I'm currently enrolled in school with Christian Institute to get my certification as a substance abuse counselor. It's broken up into seven courses. The first one was Overview of Addiction, which was about the history of addiction where I learned about addiction from Genesis to the present.

The second course is Pharmacology and Physiology, which talks about the science of different substances and how each one affects our physical and mental health. I like this one because I get to evaluate myself and understand why I did what I did in my past addictions.

The third course is Law and Ethics, which talks about drug court and treatment services and diversion programs. The fourth course is Case Management where I will learn how to create treatment plans and assess clients. The fifth course is Individual, Family and Group Counseling. I will be taught how to conduct sessions and be motivational. Course six is Personal and Professional Growth and this will go over what it means to be certified.

The final course is Supervised Practicum where I will learn the process of everything from screening and intake to consultations and record keeping. My goal is to finish these classes and stay at the ranch to keep learning office work while helping students and to learn about God's calling in my life. But ultimately I want to get back on my feet and continue to raise my son in church.
