

“ My name is Miguel Servin. I’m 39 and I’m from Modesto, California. I had a bright childhood. I had a mom and dad and three brothers and one sister. My dad passed away of cirrhosis of the liver when I was 18, and my brother Poncho was stabbed to death.

Growing up, I was influenced by TV, particularly gang-related shows and movies. I wanted to be a part of that life, and I became a gang member. I went to prison and got hooked on drugs.

I went to prison in August of 2016, and got out in April of 2017. I could feel Jesus leading me and he led me to Teen Challenge where I was able to get self-control through Christ to be able to live a godly life. I thank God for winning back everything I had lost in my life. When Jesus restored my life he showed me that just being who I am is a miracle that he’s given me.

Because the need is so great our outreach and focus is expanding. From Lodi to Kerman, from the Sierras to I-5, it encompasses 7 counties & over 1.85 million people. We are developing a network of outreaches within those communities: Turlock, Ceres, Jamestown and Lodi at the present time.
